The solar term "White Dew" is the beginning of the season of Metal. This is a time of clarity as the humidity and temperature start to fall. This is a season of transition and a common time for imbalance to arise. Pay special attention to quantity of sleep and quality of food during this time.

- Go to bed early to moderate the descending Qi of Autumn
- Support Liver Qi by increasing cooked foods with extra fiber, like cabbage, broccoli and fennel
- · Resist overeating. Try to stop eating when 80% full
